

Recipe: Cuticle Cream

“ I like this formula because the added citrus essential oils is thought to help with absorption of the natural evening primrose oil. The mineral oil is thought to help protect the nail bed from the elements while locking in moisture. User should apply cream in a circular motion with very light pressure to the nail bed and cuticle. This will provide a gentle yet stimulating massage to the cuticles. ”

Yields: Approximately 8 - 2oz Bottles

What You Need To Make This Recipe:

- 16 Ounce(s) Crafter's Choice Moisturizing Lotion w/ Evening Primrose
- 7 ml(s) Crafter's Choice Grapefruit EO 706
- 8 Clear PET Boston Round Bottles - 2 oz
- 8 Black Disc Tops - 20/2410
- Glass pyrex cup
- Microwave
- Plastic Dropper
- Spatula



Directions:

1. NOTE: If you are making these products for sale, good manufacturing practices recommend you wear a hairnet, gloves and a mask. We also recommend a clean apron.
2. Fill glass pyrex cup with lotion base.
3. Using a microwave on low heat, heat slowly until liquid. Do not overheat.
4. Add 7 ml essential oil and stir well.
5. Pour into bottles. Allow to return to room temperature.
6. Apply tops to bottles. Note: Do not put the tops on the bottles before the lotion has returned to room temperature.
7. If selling this product, label according to FDA cosmetic guidelines.
